SIGN UP

Get in touch: By Email, phone call, social media, website enquiry, or registration link.

Eligibility check: We will need to check your date of birth, postcode, and employment status.

Confirmation: We'll contact you via phone or email to confirm your place and eligibility. You'll receive course and induction details, and discuss any additional support needs.

Reminder: A text reminder will be sent 24 hours before your course induction/start date.

INDUCTION

Meet your tutor: Get to know your tutor and ask any questions about your course.

Paperwork: Complete your funding paperwork with your tutor's support.

Bring ID & documents: Please bring proof of ID, address, employment, or benefits, plus your National Insurance number.

Maths & English assessments: Complete short assessments to help us understand your support needs.

Induction Presentation: Your tutor will give a short introduction to the course, tailored to your learning.

LEARNING

Attendance: We ask that you attend all sessions. If something comes up and you can't make it, please let your tutor or the office know on 0151 294 4749.

Inclusive support: Use online delivery to access extra resources and stay connected with your tutor throughout your learning journey.

Personal Development: During your course, we'll support you to build confidence, resilience, and wellbeing as you work towards your long-term goals.

COMPLETION

End of course: Your tutor will share resources and recommendations to help you continue your learning journey.

Feedback: We will ask you to complete a short survey to tell us about your experience and help us improve.

Certificates: On successful completion of your course, you'll receive your certificate by post. Please allow up to 3 months for delivery due to quality checks.

Progress update: 3 months after your course, we'll get in touch to see how you're getting on for example, whether you've moved into work, volunteering, or further learning.
